#### **ABSTRACT**

Learners will be introduced to elements and principles of art and design in the first and second lessons where they will interact with the vocabulary of art and design. They will also explore ways in which children connect with art including the techniques and methodologies used to help them express themselves using art as a tool of communication. Learners will then experiment with various media used in art to illustrate and communicate their concepts. These media will include pencils, pen and ink, water color paints, paper and found objects. Genres of art that will be explored by learners will be drawing, painting, collage and mosaic. It is necessary for learners to do comprehensive research in the art genres and present their findings in a classroom situation. All the practical assignments done will be discussed in class through display for comments, critic and peer evaluation.
